Project #676: Spring Rain!

- Make some cloud shapes out of plain white or grey paper.
- Create raindrops by cutting out tear shaped droplets from some waxed paper or other paper.
- Create an umbrella shape.
- Give the children some plain paper such as light blue construction paper.
- Children may glue on the clouds, raindrops and umbrella in any way they like.
- Add some colour to you picture using some Felt markers or crayons.
- Try adding some silver sparkles to the rain drops by using a glue stick and shaker sparkles.
- Liquid sparkles also work for this.
- Sparkles may be everywhere but that's Art!
- Add other details like trees and flowers if you like.
- Stickers are also an option but less creative.
- Sponge paint your umbrella shape!

Activity: Go for a Rain Walk. Try it with and without an umbrella.

Song/chant:

Rain is falling Down, Splash Rain is Falling Down, Splash
Pitter Patter, Pitter patter. Rain is falling down, Splash
Sun is peeking out. Peek! Sun is peeking out. Peek!
Peeking here, peeking there. Sun is peeking out. Peek!
