Project #677: Spring Buds and Trees!

- Use a template for a tree if you like such as a photo copy of the shape.
- Cut out some tree trunk shapes.
- Cut out various branch shapes.
- Create some buds on the trees for leaves and partially grown leaves to glue onto your tree.
- Glue tree trunk and branches first.
- Add the buds and partially grown leaves next with glue (glue sticks are great for this)
- Add some more details with felt markers or crayons.
- Add other details around the tree/s by adding scenery if you like
- Clouds and the sky plus sun and rain could be added as well.
- Use textured paper as leaves and branches is also a good idea.
- Try using some natural outdoor items that you may find like moss, old leaves, and other foliage you may like.

Tall as a Tree!

Grow grow grow your leaves could be a chant or a song.

See what you can make up with a familiar tune you may like.

Start your tree growing from the ground and children may bend legs and knees and push up to to. Stretch arms like the branches and fingers could be the leaves.
