## Project #678: Spring Bubbles!

- Make a soapy solution such as from a Bubble Wand mixture.
- Add a drop of food colouring.
- See how your new bubbles work by blowing on them
- Make Bubble prints on paper.
- Lay your paper on the ground.
- When the bubbles land, you will see the imprint of the shape and size of the bubble when you add the food colouring to the bubble mixture.
- Before your bubble print is dry, try sprinkling some sparkles onto it.
- Or when the bubble print is dry, use a glue stick to spread on or around the bubble and sprinkle your sparkles on.
- Use your imagination as this could be creating the planets in the sky.
- It could be creating a rock formation on the paper.
- It may be a bubble wall.....
- Examine a bubble that did not pop on a surface. Take a photo!

Activity: Chase the bubbles with a net and try to catch them. Or let them fall to the various surfaces and see how long they last until they Pop!

Take a photo of them while in the air or on the ground!
