## Ann's Creative Corner Project #681: Farm and Animals!

- Provide children with a large poster board.
- Cut out a barn shape from a magazine or a calendar, sometimes you may find them in old books as well.
- Glue the barn onto the poster board.
- You may also like to use shapes to create the barn too. Give the children various squares, rectangles and barn shaped roof pieces of construction paper.
- Children may create their own style of barn
- Encourage making the doors, windows and hay loft.
- Add details to your barn, such as straw in the hayloft as well as barn roof and wall details of the wood for example
- Draw details around the barn such as the fields and the grass.
- Draw some sky details as well such as clouds, rain, sun etc.
- Birds in the sky may be as simple as an "m" shape.

## **Activity: Visit a Farm!**

There may be a local farm that you may like to visit or a petting zoo. There may be a sheep farm in your area to view the sheep and how they shear the sheep. You can find samples of the wool and possibly they could have a section where they create the yarn from the sheep's wool. LBU sheep farm was one in the past that was in Ladner, BC.
