Project #683: Easter Baskets!

- Cut out two basket shapes with curved lines so they look like weaving. Construction paper or stronger poster board would be good for this project.
- Cut out a long strip for a handle
- Staple the two basket pieces together leaving the top part open.
- Children may decorate the basket with colouring and stickers if they like.
- When they are done, attach the handle with tape or staples.
- Next you may like to supply some egg shapes of various colours.
- Children may colour and decorate them as well.
- Place the “eggs” into the basket by slotting them in the opening at the top.
- Try QTip Painting, sparkles, and other textures like tissue paper would give this project some depth.

Game: “A Tisket, a Tasket” Children get in a Circle. One child goes to the outer Circle and skips along behind the circle.

Singing:

A tisket, a tasket, a green and yellow basket.
