- Plastic Eggs may be found prefilled in a Grocery Store
- Plastic Eggs that can be filled with your own input may be found at a store as well.
- If you are choosing to full your own plastic eggs some ideas may be stickers, washable tattoos, soft candy, or you may like to put a small toy in them.
- Hide the “eggs” in various places in your yard or your home.
- Children may find them and also help siblings and younger children or Toddlers to find them
- Encourage helping and sharing.
- Be Mindful where you hide the eggs as it needs to be a safe place and not close to an area with mice or rats and other garbage sources.
