Ann's Creative Corner Project #687: Egg Shell Art!

- When you are done peeling your coloured or white eggs, let the shells dry out by placing them on a rack till dry.
- You may speed up the drying by placing them in a slightly warm oven as well.
- Crack the shells in many pieces of various sizes, shapes and colours.
- Supply the children with some egg shaped, firm paper such as poster board or construction paper.
- Liquid non-toxic white glue can be spread onto the egg shape in any way the child wishes.
- The egg shells can be dropped onto the glue.
- Shake off the excess shells into another pan to save for another "Egg"
- Add some sparkles to the egg.
- Add some tissue paper.
- Add some cotton.
- Think of other things you may like to add.
- Egg shells may also be glued onto see through waxed paper and placed in a window when dry.

<u>Activity:</u> Place egg shells into a plastic egg and close this with some tape. These make good shakers for music and dance!
